## 'Bend over' to serve others



Zhengkaofu was Confucius' ancestor (祖先), as well as a minister (大臣) during the Spring and Autumn Period (770-476 BC). He worked for three rulers (统治者) in the state of Song. However, even with such a high position, he was modest (谦虚的).

The next time I got a promotion (晋升), I lowered my head even further. The time I got yet another promotion, I bent over (弯下) even further at my waist (腰). When I walk, I walk along the walls of the buildings to leave the main road open for others so that nobody will think I am arrogant (傲慢的). But no one dares to look down at me or treat me badly. (一命而偻,再命而伛,三命而俯。循墙而走,亦莫余敢侮。)"

e.g. I study hard everyday so that I can get good grades in the final exam.

我每天都努力学习,以便于我能在期末考试中取得好成绩。

e.g. He runs so fast hat nobody can catch up with him.

他跑得非常快,没人能追上他。
